Ray pointed out the latest news that WHO (World Health Organisation) has certified that Africa is free now of the wild Polio virus, even despite very difficult circumstances, and that the wild polio virus remains endemic now in only 2 countries, Pakistan and Afghanistan. As World Polio Day approaches, the Rotary community is getting ready to amplify our message about eradicating polio to protect the world's children from this devastating disease.

Group 8 is meeting via Zoom tomorrow night and Ray will be attending.

Joy Mitchell reported at the Board meeting Monday night that she was still waiting for response from members and friends, without which she might not be able to organise a table for the quiz night being held on 15th October in aid of the Eastern Adelaide Domestic Violence Service.

Ray mentioned that we were pleased to endorse a local attendee for RYLA because of the offer of Campbelltown Rotary to pay for that person's attendance at the forthcoming RYLA week.
